### Job Opportunity: Wastewater Intern \$15/hour

#### Job Summary:

The Wastewater Intern will have the opportunity to assist in performing work in the operation of equipment in the wastewater treatment plant, domestic production facilities, agricultural pumping and storage facilities, and reclaimed water storage and pumping facilities, including maintenance, repair, and operation activities under direct supervision of an assigned licensed operator in the wastewater department.

#### Qualifications:

- Actively pursuing specialized training in water treatment and distribution, wastewater collection and treatment, or a related field.
- Computer experience is preferred.
- Valid California Driver's License.

#### Position Description:

- Under direct supervision maintains daily records and files associated with well, booster station, wastewater collection systems and water or wastewater treatment plant operation.
- Under direct supervision repairs, cleans, troubleshoots and maintains well, reservoir, water treatment and related equipment and systems including chemical feed pumps and systems, as well as minor building maintenance, grounds maintenance cleaning and custodial duties in assigned areas.
- Assists in operating mechanical equipment in the operation of wastewater collection systems and wastewater treatment facilities under the direction of a state certified operator grade III or higher.
- Under supervision of a D3 or above licensed personnel, may also be required to complete a daily pump route to include inspection of facilities, collection of samples, calculate chemical usage, test for chlorine residuals, maintain logs, report equipment failures, make proper adjustments to maintain proper flow in water systems.
- Compiles data and maintains records for regulatory reports for both water quality and safety issues.
- Salary \$15 per hour with no benefits. This is a part-time position available year round, beginning July 1, 2010, with flexible hours, not to exceed a yearly total of 499.50 hours.
